The Concept:

In both our professional and personal lives, relationships are the arena of our greatest challenges, yet also, of our most rewarding satisfactions. There is no individual or collective construction that can be done outside of this relational arena and we all have a responsibility of making it the place for development and growth or toxicity and decline.

As supervision or coaching professional, our responsibility lies in creating a secure, trustful and fulfilling enough relational space for our client/ clients, for them to take the risk of self-confrontation and reflexivity. It is the most important condition to help them analyse and understand the impact they have on their environment and how they are impacted by it, through "relational dynamics".

The workshop is therefore based on how we live relational dynamics and how we engage in that "relational mycelium" in which we are all involved.

Learning outcome:

Through the exploration of the relational mycelium we will explore the three cores competences for every relationship and counselling professionals:

- the interactive competence
- the somato affective competence
- the reflexive competence

We will also explore the five dimensions of the OPRP Tool, (Optimal Posture for Relation Professionals) at stake in a relational dynamic space: centration, fascination, integrity, intimacy, and contact risk taking.
